In Immanuel and Beyond

From the Finance Team: Giving in the first quarter of 2024 has exceeded our projection (based on patterns over three years). By the end of March, giving to the General Fund was \$258,000, well above our projection of \$205,000 against the 2024 budget of \$956,300. We were amazingly blessed to receive a gift of \$100,000 for the Long-Term Maintenance fund, and other gifts amounting to \$12,000 for other reserve funds (Deacons, Food Pantry, Memorial, Youth). Praise God, we're off to a tremendous start! Thank you for your faithful and generous financial support.

New Adult Ed classes have begun! Adult Ed courses take place each Sunday morning at 9:30 a.m. The following three classes will be offered during April and May.

<u>Dan Treier</u> will be teaching on the Holy Spirit in his next installment of Systematic Theology 101, in the sanctuary.

<u>Your missions team</u> will be Zooming around the World with Immanuel's missionaries over in the Ministry House. This week you can get acquainted with our dear friends Thomas and Susanna Smoak, zooming from Brazil. Adult Ed Course Descriptions, Teacher Bios.

Finally, <u>an informal parenting discussion class</u> (for both moms and dads) will meet upstairs in the Ministry House, in the classroom to the left at the top of the stairs.
