


#### WE ARE RENEWED IN GOD'S GRACE

OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE: Psalm 34:1-7 \*

<sup>1</sup> I will extol the Lord at all times:

his praise will always be on my lips.

<sup>2</sup> I will glory in the Lord;

let the afflicted hear and rejoice.

> <sup>22</sup> They came to Bethsaida, and some people brought a blind man and begged Jesus to touch him. <sup>23</sup> He took the blind man by the hand and led him outside the village. When he had spit on the man's eyes and put his hands on him, Jesus asked, "Do you see anything?"

<sup>24</sup>He looked up and said, "I see people; they look like trees walking around."

<sup>25</sup>Once more Jesus put his hands on the man's eyes. Then his eyes were opened, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly. <sup>26</sup> Jesus sent him home, saying, "Don't even go into the village."

<sup>46</sup> Then they came to Jericho. 

**Giving Update** Your support of IPC's ministry through faithful giving continues to be strong, in spite of the pandemic! Giving for the first six months of 2021 was \$384,240—1.6% below the projected income for the period of \$390,500. That is quite remarkable, given that we have had to rely heavily on mailed (including online) contributions and have not yet started to take a "normal" offering during the worship service. In addition, giving to the Renovation project in the first half of 2021 totaled \$282,294—with total giving to the project since 2019 exceeding \$900,000.
