**Giving Update:** At the end of June, giving to the General Fund was \$383,104, 8% short of our projection of \$417,700. While cash gifts remain close to last year, this is the first time in at least three years that we did not receive any stock in the first half of the year, reflecting changes in the economy. Giving to the general fund so far amounts to 44% of our annual budget of \$872,100. Though lower than projected, typically more than half of our income is received in the second half of the year. Cash reserves remain strong, so we simply ask that you continue to give as consistently as possible as we go through the annual summer slump. Thank you!
