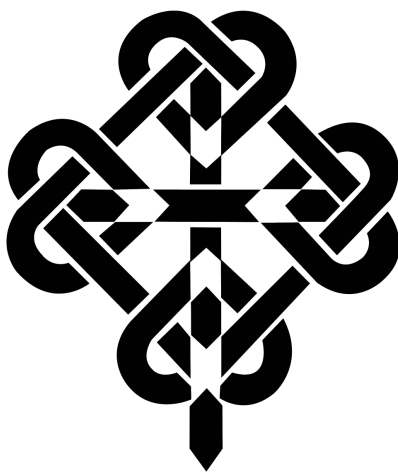

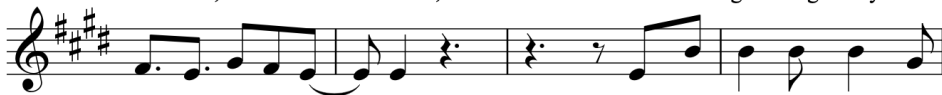

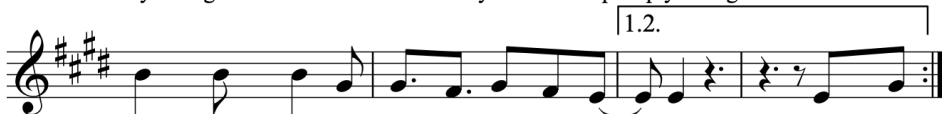

Finance Committee Update on Giving: The giving goal for the operating budget in May was \$53,000 and the actual giving was \$116,407 or 220% of the goal. Renovation giving was \$1,260 for the month. The year-to-date giving goal through May was \$303,500, and the actual giving was \$328,341 or 108.2% of the goal.
