

# WE HEAR GOD SPEAK

(Please remain standing for the reading of God's Word.) READERS: SAMANTHA AND ABIGAIL DURBIN

- OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE: Psalm 16
  - <sup>1</sup> Keep me safe, my God, for in you I take refuge.

<sup>2</sup> I say to the Lord, "You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing." <sup>3</sup> I say of the holy people who are in the land, "They are the noble ones in whom is all my delight." <sup>4</sup> Those who run after other gods will suffer more and more. I will not pour out libations of blood to such gods or take up their names on my lips.

<sup>5</sup> Lord, you alone are my portion and my cup;

you make my lot secure.

The boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places;

surely I have a delightful inheritance.

<sup>7</sup> I will praise the Lord, who counsels me; even at night my heart instructs me. <sup>8</sup> I keep my eyes always on the Lord.

With him at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

<sup>9</sup> Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will rest secure,

because you will not abandon me to the realm of the dead,

- NEW TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE: Matthew 22:23-33
  - <sup>23</sup> That same day the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to him with a question. 24 "Teacher," they said, "Moses told us that if a man dies without having children, his brother must marry the widow and raise up offspring for him. 25 Now there were seven brothers among us. The first one married and died, and since he had no children, he left his wife to his brother. <sup>26</sup> The same thing happened to the second and third brother, right on down to the seventh. <sup>27</sup> Finally, the woman died. <sup>28</sup> Now then, at the resurrection, whose wife will she be of the seven, since all of them were married to her?"

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>29</sup> Jesus replied, "You are in error because you do not know the Scriptures or the power of God. <sup>30</sup> At the resurrection people will neither marry nor be given in marriage; they will

be like the angels in heaven. <sup>31</sup> But about the resurrection of the dead—have you not read what God said to you, <sup>32</sup> 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? He is not the God of the dead but of the living."
