



**Nominate officers:** The big orange box has reappeared in the narthex, ready to receive nominations for the role of elder or deacon. Ideally, these nominations come from you! If you know of someone (who's been a member for at least a year) you'd like to see serving as an elder or a deacon, ask that person if he or she is willing to be nominated. If you get a yes, fill out the form and submit it (or contact Bill France, chair of the Nominating Committee) by November 5. The nominees will watch a series of "Learning for Serving" videos while they continue to consider moving forward. Eventually nominees will meet with elders before confirming nominations. Nominated officers are voted on at the annual church meeting in early February.

## **Financial Update**

Giving through September, cash and stock, totaled more than \$616,000, five percent above our projection (based on the pattern of giving over three years). That leaves \$255,000, or 29% of our operating budget of \$872,000, to be raised in the fourth quarter—praise God for allowing us to be in this good position!

Your generous giving over the past few years has provided sufficient reserves that we are able to pave the entire parking lot at one time this fall, at a considerable saving over spreading it out over three years. Watch for details on scheduling. This is only the first major maintenance project following the recent renovation effort. Next up will be reroofing the church building.
