

Week 5 Holy Spirit, IPC

The Transforming ministry of the Holy Spirit

1Cor. 1:30 But it is from him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification and redemption in order that, as it is written, “Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord.”

2Cor. 3:18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

Acts 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Eph. 5:18 Do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but be filled with the Spirit,

Eph. 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were marked with a seal for the day of redemption.

Mark 3:28-30 “Truly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the children of man, and whatever blasphemies they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin”— for they were saying, “He has an unclean spirit.”

The Holy Spirit: more to come

Rom. 8:23 and not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the **first fruits** of the Spirit, groan inwardly while we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies.

Eph. 1:13 In him you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and had believed in him, were marked with **the seal** of the promised Holy Spirit

Eph. 1:14 this is the **pledge** of our **inheritance** toward redemption as God’s own people, to the praise of his glory.

2Cor. 5:5 He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a **guarantee**.

2Cor. 1:22 by putting **his seal on us** and giving us his Spirit in our hearts as a **first installment**.

Incorporating us into the Body of Christ, the church

1Cor. 12:13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

Eph. 4:1-6 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Unity of Body and Distinction of Members and Variety of Services

Gal. 3:27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Rom 12:5 so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

1Cor 12:27 Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.

1Cor 12:4-7 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

The Holy Spirit and Scripture, the Word of God

Truth

John 14:17 This is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, because he abides with you, and he will be in you.

John 15:26 “When the Advocate comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, he will testify on my behalf.

John 14:26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.

John 16:13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

Inspiration

Gal. 1:11 For I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel that was proclaimed by me is not of human origin; Gal. 1:12 for I did not receive it from a human source, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

Gal. 1:6-8 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel — not that there is another gospel, but there are some who are confusing you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should proclaim to you a gospel contrary to what we proclaimed to you, let that one be accursed!

2Tim. 3:16, 17 All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that everyone who belongs to God may be proficient, equipped for every good work.

1Pet. 1:23 You have been born anew, not of perishable but of imperishable seed, through the living and enduring word of God.

Illumination

1Ths. 2:13 We also constantly give thanks to God for this, that when you received the word of God that you heard from us, you accepted it not as a human word but as what it really is, God’s word, which is also at work in you believers.

Hebr. 4:12 Indeed, the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing until it divides soul from spirit, joints from marrow; it is able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
